

Mausoleum Project

Islington & St. Pancras Cemetery, London 2019.

This recently completed mausoleum project shows an example of 'The Clifton Crescent' mausoleum, designed and built in this iconic London cemetery by Greenbridge Designs for Islington and Camden Cemetery Services (ICCS).

This impressive build was specified with 186 chambers, each large enough to accommodate American caskets and each with a corresponding lockable niche for securely holding keepsakes or cremated remains.

Greenbridge's designers worked closely with the ICCS project team to create a number of visualisations and rendered images until every last detail had been explored and agreed. Greenbridge Designs' technical capabilities allowed the designs to be digitally placed within images of the actual location in order to accurately demonstrate what the final build will look like within the landscape. We believe the result was a total success. It is very difficult to distinguish between the computer-generated final designs and photographs of the final build.

Once the plans had been approved, the materials, manufactured to the exact radius of the arc design, were on-site and with our health and safety plans in place, our fully trained and skilled build team started work. Foundations prepared, specialist machine operatives lowered the large, reinforced concrete chambers and keepsake niches with meticulous care around the curve of the foundations. The back-to-back chamber design allows for drainage to be elegantly hidden from view within the structure, whilst cleverly concealed access panels allow for future maintenance.

The installation continued over an 11-week build time, finishing with powder coated aluminium niche doors, natural quartzite stone finishing and a Firestone EPDM roof, all guaranteed for 30 years. Greenbridge Designs' final stage of the build prior to opening in August 2019 was to apply the resin bound surfaces. Soft planting brings an air of peace and tranquillity to this new, prestigious mausoleum area.

COMMUNITY MAUSOLEA

Clifton & Clifton Crescent



The 'Clifton' and 'Clifton Crescent' are elegant community mausoleums inspired by contemporary Italian architecture. The Clifton's clean lines and classic design ensures that it can seamlessly integrate into existing cemetery schemes as effortlessly as it can into new-build sites. The 'Clifton Crescent' adapts the same build principles of high-quality materials matched with clean, contemporary design that will adorn the grounds of any cemetery. The beautiful curved lines can be altered to accommodate the surrounding landscape. Each mausoleum can be made to the radius required to ensure a perfect build. The scalable designs provide architecturally pleasing buildings whether the requirement is for 12 chambers or 112.

Powder-coated, lockable doors designed to hold keepsakes or ashes. The glass panels can be substituted for granite if preferred. The interior shelf can be removed if a full height niche is required to display taller items such as flowers. The central transom can be removed to provide an uninterrupted view.

The Hallingbury



The Hallingbury is a modern mausoleum design with chambers on all four sides of the building. The exterior of the Hallingbury is a combination of large granite plaques with bronze fixings and quartzite natural stone cladding. Frames and building trims are in powder-coated aluminium as are the optional canopy frames. The canopies and windows provide shelter and natural light.

The design allows the communal space to be developed into a chapel, complete with stained glass windows, pews and an altar. This element of the design is flexible and can be designed as simply or ornately as required.

The Hallingbury makes excellent use of space and can be configured from 36 to 72 chambers. Canopies and walkways have been designed to link the mausoleum together to create a scalable, covered area for bereaved families to visit comfortably throughout the seasons.

The Medway is a traditionally built, dual-winged building designed to house between 24 and 60 chambers. The bi-fold doors and large picture windows allow plenty of light into the building, creating an airy ambience whilst providing an enclosed, secure space for quiet contemplation all year round.

The Medway has a cross gable roof over a large communal area that can be developed into a chapel if required.

The traditional, classic styling of the Medway enables it to fit easily into schemes with both modern and traditional surroundings. All sides are rendered in your choice of decorative panels so that no side looks unfinished and the building can be approached from all directions.

The Medway can be configured with multiple blocks of differing sizes and sits well alongside our other mausoleum products for when you'd like a variety of buildings in your scheme.

BURIAL VAULTS PROJECTS

The installation of burial vaults always starts with a site survey to assess the topography, existing structures, services, soil type and drainage. The layout and design of a vault installation should be meticulously and thoughtfully planned; something that Greenbridge Designs carries out with its fully trained, professional support team.

Greenbridge Designs takes health and safety seriously, which is the reason we have employed a nationally recognised consultancy firm to independently assess the work we carry out on our cemetery and crematorium projects. With assessment of our paperwork and regular on-site inspections our staff and customers are assured that all necessary guidelines are adhered to.

As with all major projects that Greenbridge Designs carries out, the design drawings are agreed and adhered to throughout

the build, and regular meetings with the client throughout the process ensure that projects are delivered as expected, safely and on-budget every time. Disruption is kept to a minimum and operational needs are prioritised.

The installation shown here in Seafield Cemetery, Edinburgh, required a fully clad and memorialised solution, one which Greenbridge Designs created specifically for this project. The design was also revised to add a foundation for the headstone, allowing interments to take place without removing the granite headstone. The granite lid was made in three pieces for ease of removal.

Burial Vaults Projects



The second installation, shown here at New Southgate Cemetery was part of Westerleigh Group's 'Grave Re-Use' project and required meticulous plotting and planning prior to works commencing. Numerous test digs were carried out to ascertain existing burial depths, and complex groundworks and drainage analysis were planned and carried out prior to installation. The resin bound pathways ensured ease of access on the slope and provided a hard-wearing, maintenance-free surface for ease of funeral operations. The slatted concrete lids were then covered with a powder-coated lid to prevent water ingress prior to burial.


Crematorium Memorial - Projects

These remembrance gardens were once an area of peace and tranquillity but, over the years, had fallen into disrepair. We were tasked with returning them to their former glory and providing a maintenance-free area that would serve the needs of the local community for many years to come.

We worked closely with the client to understand the desired look and feel, while ensuring the quantity and type of memorials was correct and suitable for future use.

To ensure we achieved this, we created a suite of existing and bespoke memorials and presented them as a series of area designs. These area designs enabled our client to visualise the bespoke memorials in situ and make any amendments easily. The project images demonstrate how close our computer-generated renders are to the final installed memorial scheme.

Once the scheme was agreed, the template for the 3500sq m site was created and manufacturing drawings produced. Tolerances had to be of the





highest order as managing slopes and radiuses gave little room for error.

Our grounds team got to work removing the unsafe pergola and memorial walls. They carefully removed the fragile slate plaques ready for integration into the new memorial. The existing surfaces were removed entirely, and the area excavated, before re-laying hard surfaces and foundations in readiness for the new memorial scheme.

It was of paramount importance to carefully choose the granite colours in order to soften the look as it is a large site using a large amount of granite. The memorial designs gave the scheme a beautiful, soft feel. From the curvaceous, stately balustrades to the towering Atlas Pillars, the design had to create interest across every angle and viewpoint.

Once the project was delivered safely and on schedule, we produced bespoke plaque inscription software, and provided training, to help our client manage future inscriptions.

Tridents

A watertight, below ground interment memorial



This memorial allows for the below ground interment of two sets of ashes within a watertight chamber. The large, removable plaque is suitable for two inscriptions that, together with a kerb-set, mirrors the look of a traditional grave. The memorial is supplied with optional vases and granite pebbles.

As an alternative, the same below ground watertight chamber is capped with two different desk-type memorials. Removal of the plaque allows for direct access to the chamber without having to remove the memorial.
